New Action Points
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Organization working in the district but not participate in the meeting.2. District authority requests the organization to submit their progress report with authority on monthly basis.3. Shelter working group will invite all the organization working in the district in the next shelter working group meeting.

1. Opening and introductions:

- Meeting started with quick round of introduction. Following organizations participated in meeting: SWG, STNAH, MDF, SDP and HANDS.

2. Shelter working Group Update :

- Emergency monsoon meeting called by district authority Kashmore and Sukkur, and highlight the variable point for flood alerts.
- District authorities announced the very high floods alerts in kacha areas of Kashmore, Sukkur, Ghotiki and Khairpur and request the community to evacuation towards the safer place to avoid the losses of life etc.
- Capacity Building Trainings on Information Management, Coordination during emergencies and CCCM held for Authorities and humanitarian organization in the District Khairpur, Ghotki, Jacobabad, Kandhkot @ Kashmore, Sukkur, Shikarpur and Qamber Shahdadkot.
- Shelter working group meeting on-going in the district Shikarpur, Kashmore and Jacobabad and provincial meeting at Sukkur once in a month.

3. Agencies updates

- **MDF:** one room shelter project in UC- Humayoon, their total target 640 shelter, till to date assessment completed and work at the excavation level, with the support of IOM and funded by DFID.
Action Point: organization share no more shelter assistance need in this UCs, as well as law and order situation isn't good in UC- Humayoon.
- **STNAH:** one room shelter project in UC- Jagan, their total target 730 shelter assessment completed 500 shelters at the excavation level, remaining work ongoing with the support of IOM and Funded by DFID.
ACTION POINT: organization share, no such security issue in the areas till now, as well as no more shelter assistance need in this area.
- **HANDS:** one room shelter project in UC- Janoo , Lodhra , Zarkhil and Pir Bux Shujra , their total target 5000 , till to date 835 shelter completed in UC- Lodhra , 800 in UC- Janoo , 640 in UC- Zarkhil and 535 in UC- Pir Bux Shujra funded by DFID.

Action Point: organization shared their 1000 old beneficiaries has some kind of the issue, under the discussion with management soon will design the strategy resolve the issue etc.

4. Information Management:

- Organization need to submitted 4Ws Matrix sheet on Monthly Basis with Shelter Working Group.

5. UC Prioritized for Early Recovery:

- Following UCs were prioritized by shelter agencies for early recovery: Amroth Sharif, Sultankot, NIM, Garhi Tego, Garhi Dakho and UC Karan.

6. AOB

- SDP organization working in the district , busy in the preparedness activities as well as they update their roster etc if any kind of the emergency they will start their assessment or collect the data and share with partners.
- HANDS started their wash activities started in the same areas where they already implement shelter activities, trained the community on health and hygiene session, distribution of tree as well as construction of the latrine to avoid the open diffusion etc.
- HANDS Organization share another project approved funded by IMC they will train the community and district authority, on social mobilization and disaster work will start soon.
- The next Shelter Working Group Meeting will be held on 9th October, 2014 at 11:30 @hrs at DC office Shikarpur.
