**I. Shelter Working Group (SWG) Updates:**

Meeting started with an overview of available information provided by SWG from government and NGO source. The 4Ws matrix has been circulated to all shelter working group members and has made it available on the SWG website as well. All present members were requested to update the working group on any distributions being planned. IOM raised the need for organizations to coordinate with the Shelter Working Group while applying for NOCs or intervene in any Union council.

## II. Shelter/ NFI Kits Distribution

- The following table gives a breakdown of Shelter/NFI Kits distribution in Chitral according to the Tehsil, Union Council and the organization.

### III. Members Organization Updates

- **Focus:** Focus have distributed 439 roofing kits in response of flood and 561 roofing kits in response of earthquake in Ayun, Chitral1-2, Denin, Garum Chashma, Karimabad ,Khot ,Koh ,Laspur, Mastuj, Shagram, Shoghore, Yarkhun union councils as IP of Acted.

With core funded, focus have distributed 901 tents, 800 food packages, 2014 blankets, 357 kitchen sets, 50 hygiene kits, 449 warm cloths and 50 bedding sets in yarkhon, karimabad, shaghore, laspur, koh, charun, arandu, garam chashma, chitral 1-2, ashiret, shishikoh, mulkoh, mastun, khot, kosht/lone, drosh 1-2, ayun, shagram and lot oweer union councils in response of earthquake. And 522 tents 928 food packages, 167 blankets, 330 kitchen sets, 330 hygiene kits 203 water cooler in yarkhon, karimabad,shoghore, laspur, koh, charun, garam chashma, chitral 1-2, shishikoh, mulkoh, mastun, khot, kosht/lone, drosh 1, ayun and shagram union councils in response of flood.

Distributed food packages as IP of WFP in Bumburet, rumboor, reshun and mulkow union councils.

The ECHO funded project is ongoing in which focus is providing 336 tents, 2 month food to 1023 families, 2188 blankets, 547 kitchen sets, 547 hygiene kits and 547 water cooler in yarkoon, shaghore, laspur, charun, garam chashma, chitral 1-2, mastuj, khot, kosht/lone, drosh-1, ayun, shagram and in mulkow union councils.
- **Islamic Relief:** In addition to previous response IR have distributed 800 blankets, 1226 winterization kits, 150 kitchen sets, 2500 jerry cans, 4500 hygiene kits, 200 tarpaulin sheets, 200 tents, 200 sleeping mats, 60 shelter kits and 900 food packages in Arandu,Ayun,Broze,Charun,Danin,Karimabad,Kosht,Laspur,LotKoh,M.cchitra,mukoh,oweer,shag ore,terich and Yarkhoon union councils.

IR work on rehabilitation of water supply in shoghore, chitral-2, ayun and mulkow union councils.

Construct 200 pit latrines in charun, ayun, shoghore and in chitral-2 union council.

Providing 14 wash room, 14 latrines, and 14 washing point in Bamborat for pregnant women.
- **Hands:** In addition to previous response Hands have 2000 winterization kits and 2000 hygiene kits for charun, mulkow, kosht and oweer union councils.

Hands have constructed 250 latrines and provided 5000 rupees in charun, muklow, kosht and oweer union councils.

Hands have planned to construct 750 shelters which they will start in April 2016.
- **AKPBSP:** As part of early recovery activity, construction of 506 one room shelters in Ayun, Charun, Khot, Kosht, Laspur, Lot Koh, and M.c Chitral, Mastuj, Mulkoh, Oweer, and shogore and yarkhoon union councils is ongoing in which 157 shelters are completed. The project date is 31<sup>st</sup> of January due to bad weather they are facing problem to complete their project in time.

- **Helping hands:** Helping hands have distributed tarpaulin sheets with comforts for 200 families in UC 1-2 and in denin union councils. HH distributed 200 winterization kits in mulkow union council.
- **CRS:** CRS have distributed cash grant among 964 families out of 1000 in laspur union council.
- **AKRSP:** AKRSP have distributed agricultural inputs ( 50kg Wheat Seeds, 50 kg Urea , 50 Kg DAP and 500 gram vegetable Seeds) to 4,000 flood communities in ayun, broze, chitral 1-2, denin, drosh 1-2, karimabad, koh, lotkoh, koh, shogore, charun and in kosht union councils.

#### **IV. Verification on extent of damages**

District authorities shared the updated damages figure for district chitral and according to the participants the authority figure are realistic.

According to government initially these figures were reported very high and after verification these figures were changed. Reason behind the change in the figures is that after disaster government issued the cheques to all of the affected families. After distributions when government announced that action will be taken against those who claimed the cheques who are non-deserving/ did not meet the criteria for cash support. Therefore, such families returned cheques to government. Government has maintained the record of cheques return. Following this updated data was shared by government and is now used by SWG members. Based on this damages figures in Chitral are different from initial reports.

#### **V. Shelter Working Group Strategy about Roofing kit and NFI**

- The strategy of safer shelter construction details was shared with member organizations.
- SWG will further share the soft copy of the construction guidelines with participants for their comments with the meeting minutes.

- Focus will share the intervention details through 4W with SWG.
- SWG will circulate the technical guidelines among members.
