I. Shelter Working Group (SWG) Updates:

Meeting started with an overview of the available information provided by government and NGO sources. The 4Ws matrix has been circulated to all shelter working group members and has made it available on the SWG website as well. All present members were requested to update the working group on any distributions being planned, along with assessment reports and/or pictures from the field. IOM raised the need for organizations to coordinate with the Shelter Working Group while applying for NOCs or any intervention.

II. Shelter/ NFI Kits Distribution

- The following table gives a breakdown of Shelter/NFI Kits distribution in Upper & Lower Dir according to the district, Union Council and the organization.

III. Members Organization Updates

- **Muslim Aid:** Muslim Aid distributed 150 Tents, 500 blankets, 500 food packages, 150 NFI, C.G.I sheets for 180 families in darangal, gambit, samarbagh, sad bakeley, mayar & miskini UCs of lower dir district.

Has planned to start shelter construction in 6 worst union councils of samarbagh. Rapid assessment done by Muslim aid in upper & lower dir.

- **SEED:** As a part of early recovery activity SEED have plan to construct 150 T-Shelters in Munda and Miankalay union councils as implementing partner of concern worldwide. Assessment is ongoing & also have applied for NOC to PDMA.
- **Literate Masses:** LM has completed an assessment in UC Rabat for distribution of 1,037 winterization kits as implementing partner of concern worldwide. LM will start distribution in coming week which is end of January.
- **ACTED:** Acted have two implanting partner, AHO & Focus. AHO has started assessment in Bajaur agency & in swat districts.

ACTED have plan to distribute 4,000 shelter repairing kits with cash grant of 5,000 rupees, 500 in swat, 1000 in lower dir, 500 in bajaur, 1000 in upper dir and 1000 kits in Chitral.

ACTED will distribute 5000 winterization kits, 750 in swat, 1,250 in lower dir, 500 in bajour, 1,250 in upper dir and 1,250 in Chitral.

ACTED will repair the 20 water point, 5 in swat, 5 in lower dir, 5 in upper dir and 5 in Chitral. Estimated cost per scheme is 80,000 PKR. 400 families will be facilitating by water filter in swat, lower dir, upper dir and Chitral.

Cash for work plan to repair path, road and debris remover. Acted will pay 1,000 man days in swat, upper & lower dir and in Chitral.

- **CCDP:** CCDP have done the assessment in upper dir; will share the assessment finding with SWG.
- **PADO:** As implementing partner of concern worldwide PADO will distribute 1500 winterization kits in zamindara and Gall union councils, distribution will start at 20 January.
- **Concern Worldwide:** In addition to above IP information, concern shared sungi foundation will construct 200 T-Shelters with 200 shelter kits in Rabat union council.

CATB is working as implanting partner in Chitral on wash and shelter. Working on rehabilitation of 6 water scheme and 5 irrigation channels. Will construct 104 pit latrines and distribute 128 tents and will work on rehabilitation of animal shelter in mulkhow and churan union council.

Concern worldwide will extend the date of call for proposal.

- **Al-Khidmat Foundation:** Al-Khidmat distributed 10,000 rupees to 163 families, 2500 food packages, 1488 tarpauline sheets, 429 tents 635 warm clothes, shawls to 400 families, 2302 winterization kits, 200 water cane in lower dir. Have constructed 20 one room shelter in Kando shamshi khan union council and will construct 14 one room shelter in adanzai & ghoriakhar union councils.

Al-Khidmat distributed 20 C.G.I sheets to 10 families of maidan and 4 families of rabat union council.

IV. Verification on extent of damages

SWG consolidated damages figures and Muslim Aid assessed figures for damages were shared in the meeting. All the members in the meeting agreed with the Muslim Aid presented figures.

Reason for agreement on the Muslim Aid figures and discarding the old figures collected by organizations during rapid need assessment is that as these figures were the updated one and the more detailed assessment was done to get these figures.

As far as government data is concerned SWG members mentioned that these figures are very low because government way of collecting figures for affected household is through the cheques issued to the affected families. Most of the affected people cheques were delayed due to some government official process that is why these figures are low. Cheques issuance process is coordinated on Tehsil level then figures are further consolidated on the district level.

V. Shelter Working Group Strategy about Roofing kit and NFI & Safe construction

The strategy of roofing kits and NFI, safe construction was shared with member organizations, SWG will share the draft version of safer construction with participants for their comments.

Action Points

- Muslim Aid will provide the assessment report and UC prioritization sheet with SWG of upper & lower dir.
- Member organization working of T-shelter or one room shelter will provide the shelter design and unit cost with SWG.
- All member organization will share their intervention details through SWG 4-W template.
