I. Shelter Working Group (SWG) Updates:

The SWG provided an overview of information available from government and NGO sources. The 4Ws matrix has been circulated to all shelter working group members and has made it available on the SWG website as well. All present members were requested to update the working group on any distributions being planned, along with assessment reports and/or pictures from the field. IOM raised the need for organizations to coordinate with the Shelter Working Group while applying for NOCs or any intervention.

II. Shelter/ NFI Kits Distribution

- The following table gives a breakdown of Shelter/NFI Kits distribution in Shangla according to the district, Union Council and the organization.

III. Members Organization Updates

- Concern Worldwide:** CWW shared the following details of Implementing partners
 - EPS:** EPS have planned to construct 250 shelters along with 250 shelter tool kits in union councils Ranyal & Sarkul of district Shangla.
 - Prepared:** Prepared is constructing 230 shelters along with 230 shelter tool kits in union councils Martung Khas.
 - SDS:** SDS has planned to distribute 1000 Winterization kits in Kuz kana, Bahlol khel and Nusrat khel union councils.

- **Islamic Relief:** In addition to previous response IR distribution 200 pit latrine, 1500 hygiene kits and working on 6 drinking water supply scheme in Alpuri and Pirabad union councils.
- **International Medical Corps:** IMC have distributed 900 blankets, 350 hygiene kits and 650 winterize kits in Malak khel and Deri union councils.
- **Helping Hand For Rural Development:** HHRD have distributed 200 blankets and 200 tarpauline sheets in Alpuri, Lilowani and Bar puran union councils. In union council alpuri HHRD also distributed 150 kitchen sets & 150 food packages. In Pirabad union council they distributed 100 winterize kits.
- **Pak Rural Development Program:** In addition to previous response PRDP have distributed 300 winterization kits in Kormang and Damorai union councils.
PRDP did the need assessment in Alpuri, Chikesar, Lilowani, Martung, Opel, kormang and damorai union councils.
- **Care & Welfare Customs Health Care Society:** CHCS have distributed food packages in district Shangla and have planned to work on shelter construction. CHCS will coordinate the SWG while intervening at UC level.

IV. Union council extent of damages:

- It was shared by the members that district authorities use to call the coordination meeting with organization working in Shangla, they shared that the government assessed figure of damages are not accurate; they asked the humanitarian actors to work according to their assessment finding.
- Member organizations present in the meeting have shared the data provided to SWG is near to ground situation and can be consider 70 % accurate, as the data came from rapid assessment not from details assessment.

V. AOB:

- Islamic Relief & other member organizations have shared the political interference is more in the district while working on relief activities.
- It was shared by a member organization that in last district authority coordination meeting, the focal person mentioned that the humanitarian actors should work on development program instead of providing small support like shelter or NFI kits.
- SWG member organizations have requested SWG to play a role to mobilize & sensitize the authorities at national level that what is the role of humanitarian actors while working in response to any disaster.

VI. Action Points

- Hands & EPS are working in the same union council, shelter working group suggested to EPS for close coordination with Hands to avoid the duplication of assistance.
- EPS have asked to share the shelter design and unit cost with Shelter working group.
- PRDP have asked to share the assessment report with Shelter working group.

- IMC & SDS have recommended the Deri, Nusrat khel and behlol khail as most worst affected union councils of the districts whose are in much more need of shelter, wash and health activities.
- All member organizations were asked to share their intervention/ plan activities details through 4-w matrix.
